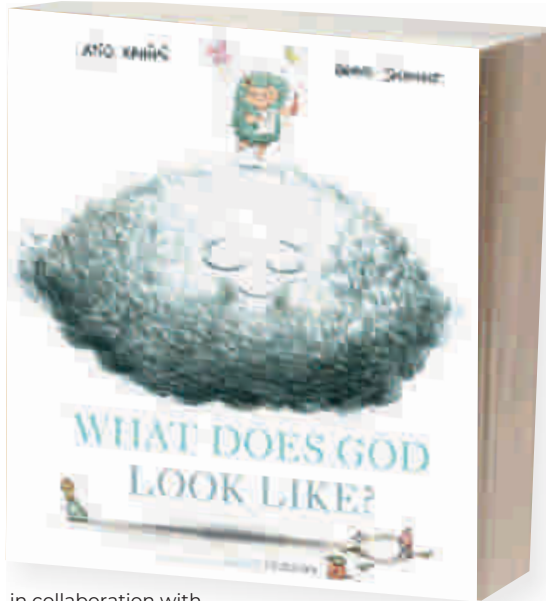

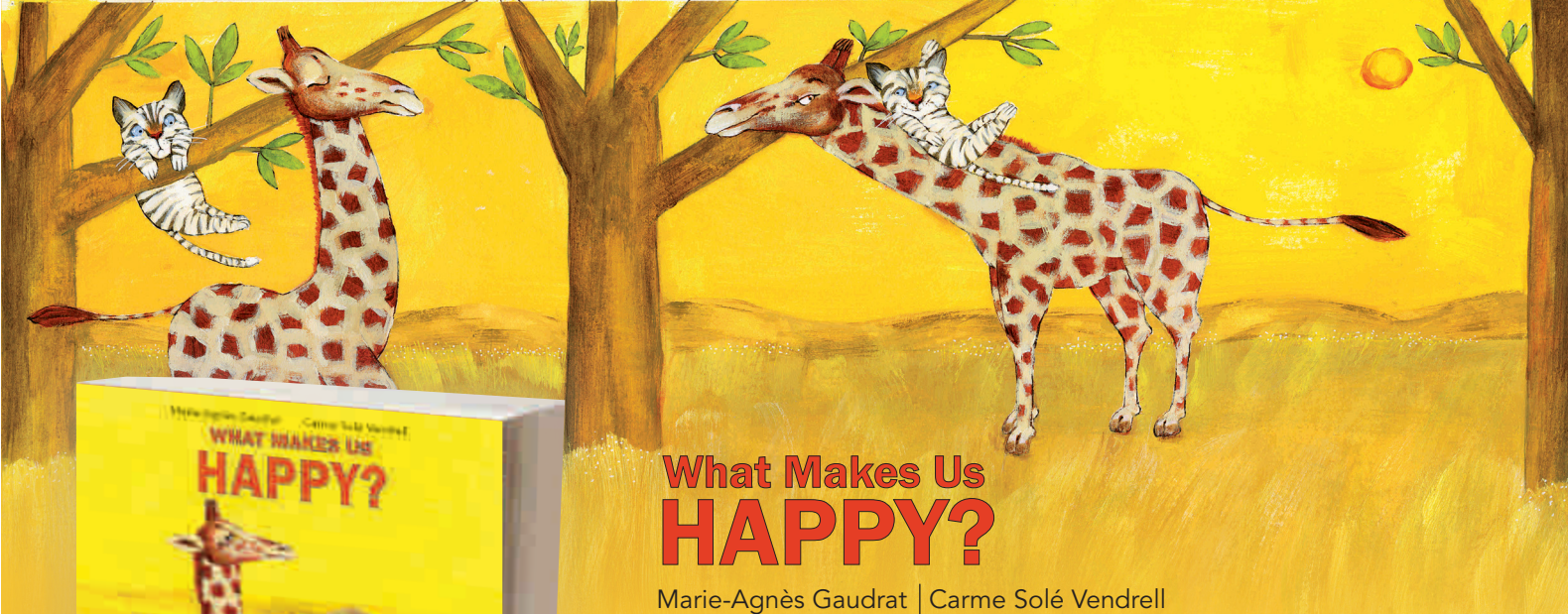

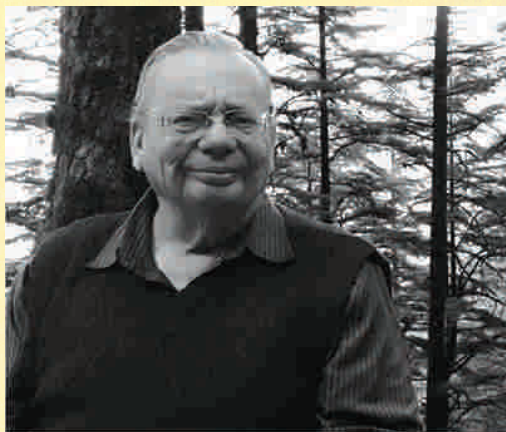

He narrates the most extra-ordinary tales from his chance encounter with Kipling's ghost, being witness to a bitter battle between a brave snake, a braver mongoose and two foolhardy birds, about the hungry python who ate up everyone's lunch and the mythical snow-woman who almost exists. The last story makes this book ever so special - as Bond recalls the last time that he spent time with his father.

Indian Folktales Retold with its eclectic illustrations by Manasi Parikh are engrossing folktales, all told with a twist. The stories, told with Bond's sparkling wit, are a treasure trove of fun and wisdom, fables of the perennial battle between good and evil in which the wise always win.

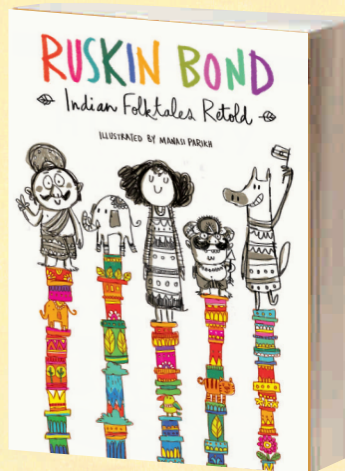
Bond spent his growing years in Jamnagar, Dehradun, Delhi and Shimla, all of which occupy a central place in his writing. After a four year stint in London and the Channel Islands in the early 1950s, Bond returned to India and made Landour, Mussoorie, his home.

A prolific writer, Bond has written several books, short stories, poems and essays. He won the Sahitya Academy Award in 1993, was awarded the Padma Shri in 1999 and the Padma Bhushan in 2014.
